

## DAY 15

**TEXT:** Jeremiah 30:17; Psalms 105:37

**TOPIC:** RESTORATION OF GOOD HEALTH

**INTRODUCTION:** God is looking to restore His people's health today. He is still on the throne. He is God of all flesh (Exodus 15:26). Job has been doing well physically, financially and health wisely until Satan attacked and killed all his children, destroyed all his businesses and afflicted his body. However, in his predicaments, Job still trusted God and remained steadfast in his faith. For these reasons God restored all his loses including his health. At a very old age, he still gave birth to children. God has not forgotten you as well. He will restore all that is dead in your body and give you sound and good health.

### PRAYER POINTS

1. Exodus 3:14; Malachi 3:6: Give thanks to God because He is I am that I am and has not changed.
  2. Jer. 32:27: Pray to God who can do the impossible to act on your behalf and make your impossibilities possible.
  3. Exodus 15:26; III John 2: Ask God for good health since that is His wish for you.
  4. Matt. 15:13: Pray to God to uproot all that He has not planted in your body.
  5. Jer. 17:14: Ask God to heal you very quickly and remove all ailments from your body.
  6. John 10:10; I John 3:8: Ask God to destroy all the works of the devil in your body (He did it for the woman with the issue of blood and others).

## DAY 16

**TEXT:** Psalm 126

**TOPIC:** RESTORATION OF OUR MINISTRY GLORY

**INTRODUCTION:** The restoration of the captivity of Zion as described in the above text refers to the return of the Israelites from their exile in Babylon. In this Psalm, God's faithfulness in fulfilling his promise to bring his people back to their homeland was celebrated. The event occurred after 70 years of captivity. It was unexpected and joyous that it felt like a dream to the returning exiles. This kind of restoration can also happen to our Ministry. Long years promises for this Ministry must also be fulfilled. Our Ministry must fulfill her purpose on earth, God must make us rejoice as individuals in the Ministry. God must disgrace all the enemies of the Ministry.

### PRAYER POINTS

1. Eph. 6:10-13: Pray to God to deal with all powers militating and opposing the glory of this Ministry.
2. Psalm 119:49: Let us plead that God will remember His promises for New Life Ministry and fulfil it.
3. Psalms 102:13: Pray that our time of visitation and restoration will come.
4. God please deal with all oppressors and captors of this Ministry.
5. Let us ask God to send down revival to us as individuals and as a Ministry.
6. Haggai 2:9; Joel 2:25-26: Pray that God will restore the glory of our Ministry.

## **DAY 17**

**TEXT:** Psalm 74:9

**TOPIC:** RESTORATION OF GOD'S POWER

INTRODUCTION: This is a time of visitation. The Holy Spirit is moving in the church to restore His power. This restoration is the Holy Spirit in a manifest and resident manner. God is ready to release those spiritual gifts to individuals as it was at the time of early Apostles. God has not changed (Malachi 3:6). Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8). The church does not need to use gimmicks to do the work of God. Individual Christians do not need occultic powers which are counterfeits like those possessed by the Egyptian magicians of Moses' day. God's power is still in operation in the lives and churches that desires it.

If you miss the time of the Holy Spirit's visitation, you will set into motion your own spiritual ruin. If you do not reach up to Him to walk in those things which belong to you and in those things He will reveal to you, your spiritual sight will grow dim.

### PRAYER POINTS

  2. Joshua 4:1-7; I Kings 18:30-32: Plead and ask God for the grace to repair your broken altar.
  3. Joel 2:25: Holy Spirit, I repent for any time I neglected my spiritual gifts. I ask you to restore them now and empower me to use them for Your glory. Let my gifts of prophesy, healing, teaching, etc. come alive again.
  4. Ezekiel 37:1-14: Breath your spirit into our leaders and our churches again that we may experience you more than the time of old.
  5. I Sam. 28:3-25; II Cor. 6:14-18: God, I repent of going to medium, witches, wizards and occultic powers as king Saul did. Have mercy on me.
  6. Romans 12:1-2; James 4:4: Give me the grace to consecrate myself and be free from worldly entanglement.

## **DAY 18**

**TEXT:** Isaiah 49:24-25

**TOPIC:** RESTORATION OF OUR COUNTRY

## **DAY 19**

**TEXT:** Isaiah 49:25; 8:9-10; 59:18-19

**TOPIC:** DELIVERANCE FROM ENEMIES

**INTRODUCTION:** God is ever ready and willing to deliver His people from their enemies, demonstrating His sovereignty and protection over those who trust in Him. This is further emphasized in Isaiah 8:9-10 where He (God) warns the nations (enemies) that their plan to attack His people will be thwarted and they will be confounded. Also, He promises to repay and destroy the enemies of His people (Isa. 59:18-19), so in the light of these promises, let us go now with confidence to the presence of God with prayer for deliverance from all our enemies, because faithful is He that has promised (Heb. 10:23). He will surely fulfil His promises.

### **PRAYER POINTS**

1. Isaiah 59:1-2; 58:9: Oh Lord, purge me with Your blood and remove anything that has been hindering or can hinder my deliverance from my enemies, help by moving me to do the needful for me to be positioned for deliverance from my enemies. Deliver me from the hand of my enemies.
  2. Isaiah 54:17; 49:24-26: Let us pray to God, to destroy every weapon of the enemies against us as we are going in this year and use His sovereign power to keep us safe from all the grip and arrow of the enemies.
  3. Isaiah 8:9-10; 7:7: Let's pray to God to scatter the association and confederacy of enemies against us and disappoint their devices by withering their hands.
  4. Isaiah 34:8; 63:4: Lord, because you said this year is Your year of recompence and vengeance, avenge us on all our enemies by your great power.
  5. Matt. 6:13: Father, deliver me from evil and protect me from harm as I'm going in this year.
  6. I Cor. 15:57: Gracious Lord, help me to live a triumphant life over every enemy and challenge for the rest of my life.
  7. Psalms 3:3: Let us pray to God to be our shield and protector from all our enemies.
  8. Deut. 20:4: Lord consider Your word and go with us in our journey of life and fight for us against our enemies.

## **DAY 20**

**TEXT:** Isaiah 49:24-26; 46:9-10

**TOPIC:** FREEDOM FROM CAPTIVITY

**INTRODUCTION:** Many people as a result of error of omission or commission have been led into and perpetually kept in captivity by their captors who since have subjected them to life of slavery making all their captives humanly efforts and attempts to free themselves fruitless. This have made such captives to lose hope of gaining their freedom. To such people, there is a good news from the sovereign Lord that whatever might be the reason for their being held captive and no matter how long they might have being in that captivity. The good Lord said He will deliver them for His name's sake (Isaiah 49:24-26), and because He has spoken it, He will bring it to pass, because He has purpose it, He will do it (Isaiah 46:10).

With this assurance of freedom from captivity, let everyone in any form of captivity come boldly with faith to the throne of mercy and claim his/her freedom today by crying aloud in prayer.

#### PRAYER POINTS

1. Isaiah 45:2; Psalms 107:16: Let us cry onto God to break every chain and bars of iron of captivity in any areas of our lives in Jesus' name.
  2. Psalms 124:7b; 91:3: My Father and my God, break every snare of captivity in my life, work, health and home in the mighty name of Jesus Christ.
  3. Acts 12:6-7; 5:18-19: Merciful God send Your Angel on my behalf to open the prison door where I have been held captive from my life and all that is connected to me.
  4. Acts 16:24-26; Prov. 6:5: Let us call upon God to help in moving us to do what will break the yoke of captivity in our lives. Let's tell God to cause great shaking in our lives for complete breaking of chain of captivity.
  5. Colossian 1:13; Gal. 5:1: Lord, deliver me from darkness, bring me into the light of Christ, deliver me from bondage and give me freedom in Christ.
  6. Psalms 18:16-17: Lord, send from above and deliver me from my strong enemies and those that hate me.

## DAY 21

**TEXT:** Jeremiah 50:33-34; 51:36

**TOPIC:** VICTORY OVER OPPRESSORS

INTRODUCTION: We are made to understand that the whole world lies in wickedness (I John 5:19b). Jesus also affirm that the princes of the Gentiles exercises authority over them i.e. oppresses them (Matt. 20:25), this shows that the act of oppression is a norms in this wicked world, that is why we see people at various cadre of authority engaging in the act of oppressing people under them in one way or the other.

In the texts for today's prayer, we read about how the people of Israel and Judah were oppressed together, by their oppressors, how they were not allowed to go free, but held them fast, but their Redeemer was strong to plead their cause and take vengeance for them.

In the same way, He (God) promise to give victory to as many that will call upon Him and to feed their oppressor with their flesh and made them to be drunken with their own blood (Isa. 49:26). What are you waiting for? Start praying to God for victory over all forms of oppression and the oppressor.

#### PRAYER POINTS

1. Isaiah 49:25-26: Oh Lord my God, I plead with You to give me victory over all my oppressors, by dealing decisively with them by feeding them with their own flesh and making them drunken with their own blood.
2. Psalms 68:1-2: Oh Lord my defender, arise and scatter all forms of oppression from my life, and cause every oppressor in my life to lose their grip and influence over me.
3. Jeremiah 20:11: My Father, my Father, show Yourself as mighty and terrible one and cause my oppressors and persecutors to stumble; make them to be greatly ashamed and be in perpetual confusion.

4. Psalms 18:17-18: Lord, give me victory over oppressors, deliver me from their hands and be my stay according to your word.
  5. Romans 8:31: My defender, use Your presence with me to terrify my oppressors and weaken their hands and influence over me.
  6. Psalms 55:16-17: You alone that answers prayer, do unto me according to this passage of the scripture by delivering me from oppression as I pray unto You.
